

After installing IE Tab (<https://addons.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/addon/1419>), use it like this:

“Left-click” the Firefox icon at the bottom of the screen (this will load the current page in an IE tab)

page has been rendered in an IE Tab

Left-Click: Switch rendering engine of current page.  
Middle-Click: Use new tab to switch rendering engine.  
Right-Click: Show IE Tab Sites Filter.

Icon has toggled to IE, signifying the present 'browser type' status

To display specific URLs (automatically) in an IE Tab (so you don't have to manually "click-back-and-forth"), right-click the icon, enter a URL, and click the "Add" button [OK] in the resulting pop-up window:
