

Guide to WIU Library Databases:

Business & Economics

Sources for Locating Journal Articles

ABI/Inform (1971-)

Indexes articles from more than 1,800 industry, management, accounting, marketing, human resources, public administration, and other business-related journals. Includes many full articles. Updated weekly.

Business Source Elite (1984-)

Indexes articles from nearly 1,800 management, economics, accounting, banking, finance, international business, and marketing journals. Almost half the journals are peer-reviewed and more than 1,100 include full text. Also includes 10,000 substantial company profiles from Datamonitor. Updated daily.

EconLit (1969-)

Corresponds to the *Journal of Economic Literature*. Provides citations and abstracts for journal articles, dissertations, books and working papers in all areas of economics. Updated monthly.

LexisNexis Academic

Includes articles from business magazines and journals, newspapers, and trade publications. Provides business and financial news, company financial information, market research, industry reports, and SEC filings.

Regional Business News (1990-)

Comprehensive full-text coverage of more than 50 business journals and newspapers from metropolitan and rural areas within the United States. Also includes a 30-day backfile of 35 newswires. Updated daily.

Sources of Other Types of Business Information

AICPA reSOURCE: Accounting and Auditing Literature

AICPA's electronic library contains AICPA Professional Standards, Technical Practice Aids, Accounting Trends & Techniques, AICPA Audit and Accounting Guides, and current Audit Risk Alerts. The most current information, plus tips and tools. Requires username and password, available at the Reference Desk.

BNA Tax Management Library

A current comprehensive federal tax resource containing codes, regulations, legislation, cases, practice tools, daily Tax Reports from the BNA State Tax Library, analysis, news and developments, articles, and commentary.

CCH Employment and Health Law (1937-)

Includes federal and state laws, regulations, standards, cases, decisions, news, analysis, and forms, in areas such as labor relations, wages and hours, human resources, equal employment opportunity, benefits, and unemployment insurance.

CCH Tax Research Network (1913-)

Provides federal and state tax codes, cases, citations, analyses, interpretation and rulings, and IRS publications.

MRI

Offers comprehensive demographic, lifestyle, product usage, and media data. MRI annually surveys more than 20,000 U.S. consumers and provides summary tables of key audience and product usage data. Requires registration, which is free, or you can get login information at the Reference Desk.

Value Line Investment Survey

Source of current information and advice on approximately 1,700 stocks, more than 90 industries, the stock market, and the economy. Reports contain Value Line's Timeliness, Safety, and Technical rankings, financial and stock price forecasts for the coming 3 to 5 years, an analyst's written commentary, and historical financial data. VL also ranks each of the stocks for probable performance relative to each other during the next six to 12 months.
