

Guide to WIU Library Databases:

Recreation, Sports, & Tourism

SPORTDiscus (1949-) Indexes journals, books, proceedings, and web sites in sports medicine, exercise physiology, biomechanics, psychology, training, conditioning, nutrition, coaching, physical education and fitness, and other sport- and fitness-related topics. SPORTDiscus also provides comprehensive indexing of the Microform Publications collection of dissertations and theses of the International Institute for Sport and Human Performance. Updated quarterly.

SBRNet (Sports Business Research Network) Combines market research from the National Sporting Goods Association and sports governing bodies with industry news covering all facets of the sporting goods and sports marketing industry, including sports equipment sales, sports participation, sports broadcasting, sports sponsorship and sports marketing. SBRnet has also added **buyTRACK**, an exclusive tracking study of sporting goods purchasing habits on the Internet.

Leisure, Recreation & Tourism Abstracts [Leisure Tourism Database] (1973-) *LRTA* cites internationally published research from more than 400 journals in the leisure, tourism, recreation, hospitality, sport and cultural industries. The online version is enhanced with new academic research, industry reports, books, book reviews and news from the various industries. Updated weekly.

Hospitality & Tourism Index (primarily 1980s-) A bibliographic database covering scholarly research and industry news from more than 500 journals relating to all areas of hospitality and tourism. Subject areas covered include demographics & statistics, development & investment, food & beverage management, hospitality law, hotel management & administrative practices, leisure & business travel, market trends, technology and more. Sources are both domestic and international in range and scope, Updated semimonthly.

Business Source Elite (1984-)

Indexes articles from nearly 1,800 management, economics, accounting, banking, finance, international business, and marketing journals. Almost half the journals are peer-reviewed and more than 1,100 include full text. Also includes 10,000 substantial company profiles from Datamonitor. Updated daily.

ABI/Inform (1971-)

Indexes articles from more than 1,800 industry, management, accounting, marketing, human resources, public administration, and other business-related journals. Includes many full articles. Updated weekly.
