

Example of how to estimate your grade in Math 100.

- There are four subscores that make up your grade.
(See the syllabus.)
You can look on WesternOnline and see your scores

Example:

- Homework: $\frac{17.2}{20}$

- Exams: $\frac{26}{40}$

- (Final exam: nothing yet)

- Other: $\frac{19.1}{20}$

$$\frac{17.2 + 26 + 19.1}{20 + 40 + 20} = \frac{62.3}{80} = .77875 \approx 77.9\%$$

After the final exam has been taken, that gets added in,

NOTE: Some grades may be blank in the gradebook. If these grades are not resolved by the end of the semester, they will be turned to a 0.
Two low homework grades (the lowest) are dropped.
