IndexCopernicus is an index published in Poland that contains information contributed by users and publishers. It does not include titles from major journal publishers like Elsevier, Wiley, Taylor & Francis or Sage. Check it for journals from major organizations in your field. Are they included in *IndexCopernicus*?

DOAJ is a directory.

This journal is not indexed in **ERIC, Scopus** or **EconLit**.

ISI – The Institute of Scientific Information is the company that originally developed Science Citation Index, Social Science Citation Index and Arts & Humanities Citation Index. These publications are now owned by Thomson Reuters. The announcement does not list a specific index by title, just ISI, a company which no longer exists – it was bought out by Thomson Scientific in 1992, which changed its name to Thomson Reuters when they were acquired by Reuters in 2008. Shouldn't a reputable publisher know this?
