Remember, this should not simply be the story of your teachers and you, but about the roles in which we are cast, whether we choose them or not, by our culture and its institutions. The important question, again, is not who you were or who your teacher was, but what roles you played and how those roles can now lead you to understand and critically discuss the process of education.
