## **Research Essay Proposal**

Due March 27

At the top of the proposal, place your hypothesis, which is the conclusion you imagine that your research will reach. The form of an hypothesis is basically the same as a thesis, yet the thesis of your essay may turn out to be quite different. This section should be headed, <u>Hypothesis</u>.

In a few paragraphs, outline your project, including the primary text(s) you intend to use and the approach you're taking toward it (or them). This section should be headed, <u>Outline</u>.

Provide a list of possible research sources, which you do not need to read in advance. The more possibilities you have, the better, not just for the research essay, but also for the annotated bibliography. This section should be headed, <u>Sources</u>.

The proposal should reach at least two pages.
