

# How to calculate your 2016-17 WIU/UPI dues!

## Here's how UPI's yearly dues for bargaining unit members are calculated

- 1. Take the member's annual base salary and multiply it times **0.6%**;
- 2. Any member whose base salary is **\$58,446.00** or more will pay the total amount that UPI pays to its affiliates, **\$592.46**, in addition to the amount in #1.

### OR

3. Any member whose base salary is less than \$58,446.00 per year but more than or equal to \$15,157 and all WIU Pro Technical unit members will pay \$316.63 in affiliation dues in addition to the amount in # 1.

### OR

4. Any member whose base salary is less than \$15,157 per year but more than or equal to \$9,203 will pay \$178.72 in affiliation dues in addition to the amount in # 1.

## OR

- 5. Any member whose base salary is less than \$9,203 per year will pay \$109.76 in affiliation dues in addition to the amount in #1.
- 6. Then divide the resulting total in line 2, 3, 4 or 5 by the number of a member's pay periods per year.

The formula would look like the following...

0.6% X base salary + affiliation dues
Pay periods per year
