Berry has expertise in equity issues in mathematics education, as well as classroom observation and incorporating engineering principles into mathematics education.



**Reggie Duncan** is a fifth grade mathematics and science teacher at Wingate Elementary School in Shiloh, IL. He is the 2016 ICTM Excellence in Elementary Mathematics award winner, as well as a member of the ICTM Board of Directors; he was also a Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching finalist in 2016. He has worked on the Math Model Resource Project Team to facilitate educators' transition to the New Illinois Learning Standards, as well as serving as an Area Teacher Leader for the I-STEM project.
