

COMPEER FINANCIAL SCHOLARSHIP

HISTORY: The Compeer Financial Scholarship was established at Western Illinois University in the spring of 2009 by 1st Farm Credit Services. The Purpose of the Scholarship is to give financial assistance to students majoring in agriculture at Western Illinois University.

CRITERIA: Each applicant/candidate/recipient for the Compeer Financial Scholarship:

Must be enrolled as a full-time student in good standing at Western Illinois University with a declared first major and sequence in the School of Agriculture. May be a new freshman or transfer student, or a currently enrolled student from one of the following counties: *Adams, Boone, Brown, Bureau, Carroll, Cook, DeKalb, DuPage, Fulton, Grundy, Henderson, Henry, Hancock, Jo Daviess, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, Knox, Lake, LaSalle, Lee, Livingston, Marshall, Mason, McDonough, McHenry, McLean, Mercer, Ogle, Peoria, Pike, Putnam, Rock Island, Schuyler, Stark, Stephenson, Tazwell, Warren, Whiteside, Will, Winnebago, Woodford.*

Must demonstrate strong academic performance based on high school, college and university academic performance, ACT score, and other indicators.

Preferably will have a minimum GPA of 3.0/4.0 in current high school, college, or at Western Illinois University to receive this scholarship award.

APPLICATIONS: Applications are available at www.wiu.edu/ag

TERMS: Awards will be \$1500 per year (distributed at \$750 per semester following certification of qualification).

SELECTION PROCESS: Scholarship recipient may be based on high school and/or college/university academic record, ACT score, and other indicators of academic performance. Financial need may also be considered.
