I verify that I have been informed of my rights and privileges as outlined above. I understand that all information revealed in these sessions will be held in strictest confidence, except for the reasons outlined above or when authorized by me, in writing, to release it.

I also authorize the video recording of any sessions that I attend. I understand that the recordings will remain the property of the Western Illinois University Department of Counselor Education. I also understand that these recordings are used for supervision, with full recognition given to the rights of the individuals involved.

I further consent to allowing graduate counseling students, supervisors, and instructors to observe the counseling sessions in progress.

I understand that my counselor generally may not condition counseling services upon my signing an authorization unless the counseling services are provided to me for the purpose of creating health information for a third party. I understand that I have the right to inspect the disclosed mental health information at any time. I understand that Illinois law prohibits re-disclosure of any information disclosed to the recipient pursuant to this authorization unless this authorization specifically authorizes such re-disclosure.
