## Point System for Phi Epsilon Sigma Recognition at Graduation – Cord<sup>\*</sup>

- 1. Must have been an "active" member for at least 50% of the semesters the student was eligible beginning no earlier than student's sophomore year.
- 2. Active members are defined as:
  - a. Paid dues for the semester
  - b. Accumulated at least 5 points for a semester or 10 points for an academic year:
    - 1 pt for attending a meeting
    - 2 pts for leading a study session at which at least 1 KIN student attends and participates
    - 2 pts for participating in a service activity (ex. dog walking, helping with the Donna Phillips Run, bell ringing for Salvation Army, helping with We Care Day, Stuff the Bus, etc)
- 3. Additional ways to accumulate points:
  - a. 4 pts per semester for being a member of the Executive Board (President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer)
  - b. 3 pts for coordinating a service activity (ex. Shoe drive, Coat drive, Water Fund Raiser, etc)
  - c. 3 pts for chairing a committee (ex. Organizing the Study Sessions)
  - d. 2 pts for being a member of a committee (ex. member of Study Session committee)
  - e. 1 pt for helping serve at a graduation reception
