THE MARTIN DUPUIS MUKTI FUND LEADERSHIP AWARD IN GAY, LESBIAN, BISEXUAL, AND TRANSGENDER COMMUNITIES

The Dupuis/Mukti Fund Leadership Award in Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender Communities will recognize a student who has provided leadership in gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, etc. (GLBT) groups and/or concerning GLBT issues at WIU. Eligible students must be a returning undergraduate for the 2025-2026 academic year who has not previously won the award. Preference will be given to a junior returning to WIU for their senior year.

The selection of the Dupuis/Mukti Fund Leadership Award in Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender Communities shall be made by the University Committee on Sexual Orientation and Gender Identity/Expression (UCOSOGIE). The award of approximately \$2,000 will be distributed by check in two installments, half in September 2025 and half in February 2026. The deadline for paper submissions is Friday, February 28, 2025, and the deadline for electronic submissions is Saturday, March 1, 2025.
