Vote this November!

This guide provides information on voter registration and regulations in Illinois, focusing on McDonough County, Illinois. To vote in Illinois, an individual must be:

- 18 years or older on the next election day
- A resident in the jurisdiction for 30 days prior to the election, and
- A U.S. citizen

Illinois' residents may register to vote at their local election authority, Driver's license facilities, with appointed deputy registrars, or by mail. McDonough County residents can register at the McDonough County Clerk's office in the Courthouse or at the State Drivers License Examiner's office at 466 Deer Rd, Macomb IL 61455. The Drivers License office is closed on Mondays. Voter Registration Deadlines are:

Request Absentee Ballot: September 25, 2008

Register to Vote: October 7, 2008

Grace Period Registration and Voting: October 8 - 21, 2008

Early Voting: October 14 - 30, 2008

Early Voting (Memorial Union Concourse): October 21-23 &

October 27-30, 2008
