Family Resources has a variety of services that are provided to the community. We offer resources, advocacy, and counseling to survivors of: sexual assault, domestic violence, homicide and other violent crimes, and human trafficking. Family Resources acknowledges that anyone can be a survivor and offers LGBTQ+ advocacy to ensure that we are inclusive with our services that we are providing. Advocacy could be anything from general, legal, civil, and/or medical advocacy. Child Foster Care and shelter for survivors are also important sections of Family Resources. Among these services Family Resources provides, we also offer outreach and education to the community about these services and awareness of these issues with in our community.

As the Campus Coordinator for Family Resources, I provide many different services. I primarily work with local colleges in Illinois such as Black Hawk College, Western Illinois University, and Augustana College. At these colleges, I serve as a Confidential Advisor in Title IX and Sexual Misconduct cases and hearings. This means I help student survivors decide what their next moves are after disclosing along with offering emotional support, services, and resources. I also work as a Sexual Assault/ Domestic Violence Advocate and Counselor to students and to survivors in the community. I can offer a combination of these services depending on the needs of the survivor. Additionally, I also provide training and outreach within the community about the services I and Family Resources as an institution provide. The job of Family Resources over all is to empower survivors in any way we can and to be an emotional support and advocate as they navigate their trauma.
